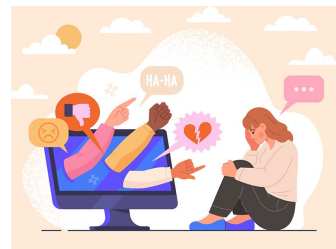

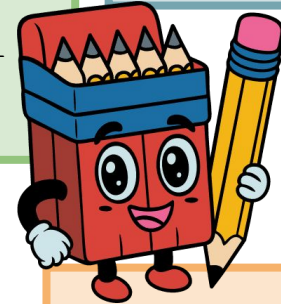


Research, design and create your own fabric pencil case.



You will learn to play the ukulele and perform as part of a cohesive group.

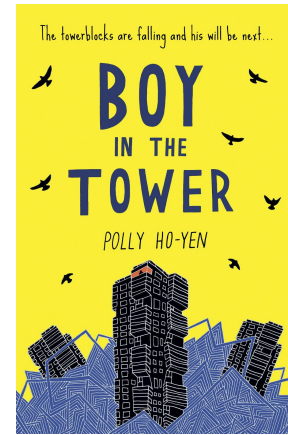
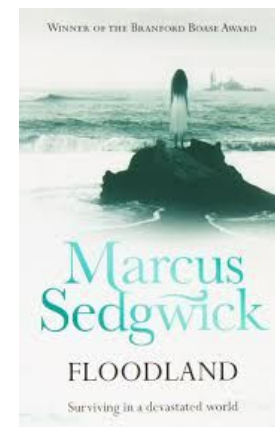
Using mixed media you will create your own planet artwork.
